## Curriculum Overview

Subject: English Literature

Year Group: 11



Students will have covered the entire syllabus for English Literature by Year 11, which means they will focus on refinements of exam techniques and development of higher level essay writing skills. Students will use Massolit lectures videos, Seneca learning platform and a range of additional learning sources to build on knowledge of the contexts and critical interpretations of the set texts. Students will be practising past paper questions and using mark schemes to level and critique sample answers. Revising these set texts, students will focus on key scenes and sample exam questions, using the PLC to develop their weaknesses across the A0s.
