Subject: German

Year Group: 10

Students from first teaching 2024/25 are following the new AQ GCSE specification for German. Content is topic-based and divided into three main themes of people and lifestyle, popular culture and communication and the world around us. Grammar and key structures are taught within the topics but are transferable across content. There is great focus placed on phonics and accurate pronunciation. Students will be able to produce written and spoken German in three tenses and will begin to understand and manipulate the language they have learnt in line with the specification.
