Set in the 1930s in Alabama, the novel explores the idea of justice, the loss of innocence and the realisation that a place can be both a beloved childhood home and a source of evil.






Roll of Thunder Hear my Cry By Mildred D. Taylor

When an alien spaceship lands on Earth, crowds of onlookers gather. But wonder soon turns to terror when the Martians emerge armed with deadly heat rays.








