Students learn whole class and group singing, using the voice to compose aria & recitative, vocal technique and all things musical theatre. Students also perform a well-known musical song as a whole class.	Students learn the most important terminology in music and basic entry level Drum Kit, Bass, Guitar, Ukulele, Keyboard & Voice.	Students will begin to learn how to use Logic software and take their first glimpse into film music by composing leitmotif for still image. They will use software instruments and keyboards to input their work. They will also use their new skills to sfx a piece of cartooning.	Students study keyboard skills independently using the Chase Award graded booklet. Students are expected to take the test at the end of each learnt piece. Students will also learn about the instruments of the orchestra and instrumental families.	Students will learn how to play the djembe drum and explore the significant drumming cultures from around Africa. Students will then use what they have learned to compose and perform their own group piece using only percussion.	Students will create their own bands in groups of 4/5, they will then learn, practice, rehearse and perform the song they have chosen from a limited list. Students will specialise in an instrument.
