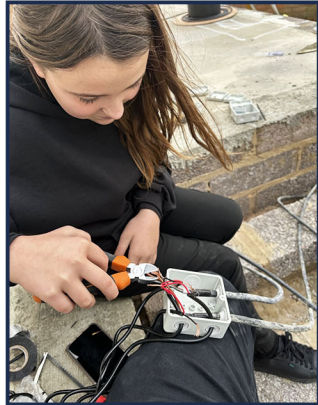
Headteacher's Comment:
