**Dear Parent/Carer,**

**Re: Bromcom Student App and Microsoft Single Sign-On**

We are writing to let you know about an important change to how students will access homework and other key school information.

Students will need to **download the Bromcom Student App immediately**, as this will be used to access and manage homework alongside other important information such as timetables, attendance and school updates. It is therefore important that all students have the app installed and are able to log in as soon as possible.

Students will access Bromcom using their existing **school Microsoft account**. This is known as **Microsoft Single Sign-On (SSO)**. In simple terms, this means students do not need to remember a separate username and password for Bromcom. Instead, they select **Sign in with Microsoft** and use the same school email address and password that they already use to access Microsoft 365.

We are using the same login method across a number of our online learning platforms. Students will therefore use their **school Microsoft login** to access:

- Bromcom Student App
- Sparx Maths
- Sparx Science
- Sparx Reader

Using one secure school login across these systems makes it easier for students to access their learning and reduces the number of different usernames and passwords they need to remember.

When logging in, students should:

1. Download and open the **Bromcom Student App**.
2. Select **Sign in with Microsoft**.
3. Enter their school Microsoft email address.
4. Enter their usual school password.

Students should not create a separate personal account or use a personal Microsoft, Google or Apple account. As the Bromcom Student App will be used for **homework**, we ask that parents and carers support us by ensuring that their child downloads the app and successfully logs in **as soon as possible**.

Students should then check the app regularly for homework, deadlines, timetable information and other important updates.

If a student has forgotten their school Microsoft password or is unable to log in, they should speak to a member of staff so that we can support them.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us ensure that all students are ready to access their learning effectively.
