Re: KS3 End of Year Assessment Weeks

We would like to inform you that the KS3 End of Year Assessments will take place over the coming weeks. These assessments provide pupils with the opportunity to experience the routines and expectations of formal examinations and play an important role in measuring attainment and progress.

The outcomes of these assessments will be used to help assess each pupil's progress and will contribute to their end-of-year reports.

Key information regarding the assessments is outlined below:

- Pupils will complete end-of-year assessments in the majority of their subjects.
- Most assessments will take place during normal lesson times and under exam conditions within the classroom.
- English, Mathematics and Science examinations will take place between 15 and 19 June 2026 in the Sports Hall . On these days, pupils should attend their normal Period 1 or Period 3 lesson, where they will receive their registration mark. Their teacher will then accompany them to the Sports Hall and remain with them during the examination.
- Each pupil will receive an individual assessment timetable which will include their allocated seat number.
- Pupils should bring their bags and coats with them to the assessment venue.
- All pupils must come fully equipped with:
 - Two black pens
 - A pencil
 - A ruler
 - A calculator (required for Mathematics and Science assessments)

Please find attached the timetable for the English, Mathematics and Science assessments. This timetable has also been uploaded to Satchel One for pupils and parents to access.

For all other subjects, teachers will inform pupils directly of when their assessments will take place.

We would appreciate your support in ensuring that your child attends school punctually, is fully equipped for their examinations, and is well prepared during the assessment period.
